This will be the only planned break during each day. Official practice for the afternoon session will be taken during this time. All archers will go into the Head to Head: higher placed archers will receive a bye in the earliest round. The event will be shot in line with FITA rules 2006. All individual matches will comprise of 12 arrows per archer.
