Shooting	Sighters at 10.00am 6 arrow ends
GNAS Cards	Will require to be shown – archers who cannot show a card or receipt will <b>NOT</b> be permitted to shoot.
Dress Regulations	This is not a record status shoot therefore dress regulations will not be enforced although this year dress should be on a tartan basis. (Not compulsory)

Awards (All handicap Based)	Overall awards shall be given according to entries received subject to a minimum of: - 1-2 entries = Trophy + Gold only, 3 = Gold & Silver, 4+ = Gold, Silver & Bronze.  Junior and Novice awards will also be given
