



**AGENDA ITEM 8:**

**Proposed amendment to age of voting at Scottish Archery General Meetings (Special Resolution ~ requiring 75% of votes cast to be in favour of the resolution to pass)**

The Articles of Scottish Archery currently limit voting rights to those who are aged 18 and over. Scottish Archery is committed to full compliance with the Equalities Act of 2010. This, long with the introduction of the new Standards for Wellbeing and Protection of Children in Sport means there is an expectation that sport governing bodies will have a far greater focus on including young people in decision making for their sport and that their voices will be heard for all areas of the sport that may have an impact on them.

**It is therefore proposed that a Special Resolution be passed to reduce the voting age for Members from 18 to 16.**

(Note: As at the end of September 2018 this would effectively increase voting membership by C100 requiring an additional 10 proxy votes to be submitted at General Meetings and no requirement for additional members attending General Meetings)
