Directions:

From the M27 Junction 11 Head to Fareham town go in the left hand lane throw the lights turning left stay in that lane across roundabout stay in left lane follow that road till you get to the next roundabout move to the right hand lane and go straight at the roundabout then 3 exit . You are now on military road, carry along that road the venue is at the other end of this road on the right hand side just before a roundabout (Please note post code PO123TR is for pub across the road)

Security:

There is secure parking at the competition venue, and a secure room available for equipment for those archers who wish to leave their equipment at the venue. There will be event personnel and work party at the venue on a 24 / 7 basis.

Compound Archers will consist of 15 arrows matches shot in five ends of three arrows at 50M

Recurve Archers will consist of 15 arrows matches shot in 5 ends of 3 arrows 70 Metres.

Accommodation:

Rees Hall, University of Portsmouth

Travel to Accommodation

Road

Exit the M27 at Junction 12 for Portsmouth West (M275). At the end of the M275 follow signs for the seafront through the city. As you reach the seafront, Rees Hall is immediately on your left. We can provide limited parking for blue badge holders on a first-come, first-served basis. Onroad car parking is available outside Rees Hall. Additional car parking is available at the Isle of Wight Hovercraft terminal, located only 200 metres away.

For sat nav users, the postcode is PO5 3AP.

Train

Portsmouth is served by direct rail services from London, the south west and the Midlands. The city has two central stations: Portsmouth Harbour and Portsmouth & Southsea. We advise you alight at Portsmouth Harbour. The station is approximately one mile from Rees Hall.
