

Scottish Rankings Criteria 1st October – 31st March Target Indoor Senior and Junior



The indoor rankings are compiled from an average of an archers top 3 five dozen round scores shot in open competition with judges officiating. Tournaments that have a field captain rather than judges will not be included in the rankings. All scores will be converted to an 18m for ranking purposes.

All WA and Imperial round session scores will now be accepted for ranking.

The indoor rankings will run from 1st October and close on the 31st March.

Junior archers will be ranked as junior lists but will also be ranked with the seniors as they shoot the same rounds and distances.

Scores shot out with the UK shall be at internationally recognised events, typically World record status. The responsibility lies with the archer to provide substantiation for claimed scores by identifying a web link or other form of independent verification. (Paper copies of results are not acceptable).

Scores shot out with Scotland should be notified no later than 7 days following the shoot.

The following information should be supplied:

- a) Name of archer.
- b) Discipline.
- c) Type of round shot.
- d) Score for that round.
- e) Name and date of tournament.
- f) Results sheet

Should any variance between the claimed score and published results be noted then the lower score will be recorded.

Any score submitted after 30th March will NOT be included in the rankings. Final rankings will be published by the end of April each year.
