Home Nations Trophy: Highest combined score from one senior male, female & junior (boy or girl) Club Trophy: Highest combined score from one senior male, female & junior (boy or girl).

University: Highest combined score from one gentleman & one lady from the same university (no trophy - awaiting donation) Couples' Trophy: Highest scoring married couple.

Other Details: Subject to space being available, archers in other disciplines may shoot, but will be put on a holding register and will not be advised if space is available until Tuesday 20th November 2018
