



Scottish Rankings Criteria
1st April – 30th September 2018
Target Outdoor Senior and Junior

From 2018, the Outdoor target rankings will be compiled from an average of an archer's top 4 round scores shot in open competition with judges officiating. Tournaments that have a field captain rather than judges will not be included in the rankings. All scores shot in a recognised Archery GB / World Archery round can be submitted, and using the Archery GB handicap tables, will be converted to an WA720 Score for ranking purposes.

All WA and Imperial round scores will now be accepted for ranking. The outdoor rankings will run from 1st April and close on the 30th September.

Junior rankings will be compiled as for the seniors but from the appropriate rounds as per the junior age groups, and will be ranked separately from the seniors.

Scores shot out with the UK shall be at internationally recognised events, typically World record status. The responsibility lies with the archer to provide substantiation for claimed scores by identifying a web link or other form of independent verification. (Paper copies of results are not acceptable).

Scores shot out with Scotland should be notified no later than 7 days following the shoot. The following information should be supplied:

1. a) Name of archer.
2. b) Discipline.
3. c) Type of round shot.
4. d) Score for that round.
5. e) Name and date of tournament.
6. f) Results sheet

Should any variance between the claimed score and published results be noted then the lower score will be recorded.

Any score submitted after 1st October will NOT be included in the rankings. Final rankings will be published by the end of October each year.
