

Scottish Team Selection for Junior Commonwealth Championship for Europe (Euronations) July 30th to July 31st 2018

Eligibility

- See eligibility criteria
- Archers must turn 18 in 2019 or later to be eligible

Competition

- Six recurve and six compound archers will represent Scotland
- A World Archery (WA) 720 will be shot on the first day followed by mixed team H2H's

Team Selection

- Three scores from a Scottish record status shoot or higher with a maximum of two scores coming from the previous outdoor season which will be defined as starting from 8th July 2017
- Those wishing to be considered must send notice to performance@scottisharchery.org.uk before 9pm on April 27th 2018
- Selection will close 24th June with scores to be submitted no later than 9pm on 25th June 2018
- Scores from WA 720's shot at 50m for compound archers or 60m and 70m for recurve archers can be submitted to performance@scottisharchery.org.uk

- Team will be announced on the Scottish Archery website and via email on June 30th

- This tournament will be incorporated in to the Archery GB Youth Festival which runs from July 29th to August 3rd 2018
