

Scottish Team Selection for Junior Outdoor Home Nations 7th & 8th July 2018, Lillieshall

Eligibility

- Affiliated to Scottish Archery
- Two years of continuous residency in Scotland at the time of event and/or those who have one or more parent born in Scotland
- Having not shot for a national governing body other than Great Britain at a World Archery event within the last twelve months

Competition

- Six recurve and two compound archers will represent Scotland in the Home Nations Match on the 7th July
- There will be UKRS, imperial rounds on 8th July which will be for the Junior National Outdoor Championships (JNOC)

Team Selection

- Three scores from a Scottish record status shoot or higher with a maximum of two scores coming from the previous outdoor season which will be defined as starting from 1st June 2017
- Selection will close on the 3rd June 2018 with scores to be submitted no later than 9pm on 4th June 2018
- Scores from any age appropriate twelve dozen round can be submitted to performance@scottisharchery.org.uk

- Team will be announced on the Scottish Archery website and via email on 6th June 2018

- All archers wishing to be considered **MUST** be entered in to the JNOC before the closing date via Sport80 website. Please ensure that you check the event prospectus to ensure that you enter the correct age group
