SCOTTISH RECORD /THISTLE STATUS CRITERIA

Any open tournament which has a regional judge in attendance may be classified as Scottish Record/Thistle Status provided it is run to the equivalent standard of UKRS for the round being shot.

If the judge in charge feels that the tournament has not been organised to the required standard or that the equipment is not the standard required for such a competition the judge will submit a report to the SAA to that effect and the record status may be reviewed and may be revoked depending on the comments made in the report..

Tournament organisers must ensure they notify the Judge Liaison Officer (JLO) of a requirement for a Regional judge at LEAST 3 months before the event to ensure there is a regional judge available.
