

Selection of Scottish Senior Teams 2017

General Eligibility for Scottish Team

1. Affiliated to Archery GB and Scottish Archery.
2. Scottish by birth OR one Scottish parent OR one year continuous residency in Scotland prior to the date of selection (students at Scottish Universities, resident in Scotland during term time are also eligible).

Please submit scores by email to saa.performancedirector@gmail.com by 7pm on the closing date of the selection period (detailed below).

Please ensure your submission email clearly states:

- 1 – total cumulative score**
- 2 – date, competition, round and result for all submitted scores**
- 3 – copy of or link to result sheet for scores shot outwith Scotland**

Senior Euronations – 30th June – 1st July 2017

Senior Euronations will be hosted by RN South Coast Archers and English Archery Federation

Venue: HMS Sultan, Gosport, Hampshire

Competition Format:

Team Selection:

Team will comprise 3 archers in each division (gents recurve, ladies recurve, gents compound and ladies compound).

Team will be selected based on scores from WA 1440 and WA 70m/50m rounds shot at Scottish, UK or World record status shoots. [conversions from Imperial rounds are not eligible for selection]

Archers are asked to submit scores to a maximum of 4320 points:

- must include a minimum of 2 x WA 70m/50m scores and 1 x WA 1440 score
(i.e. archers may submit 1 x 1440 + 4 x WA 70m/50m or 2 x 1440 + 2 x WA 70m/50m)

Due to limited selection period and availability of shoots in Scotland, one score may be used from the 2016 outdoor season (either 1 x WA 1440 or 1 x WA 70m/50m). The remainder of the scores must be shot in the 2017 outdoor season.

PROVISIONAL Deadline for Submission of Scores: 7pm on Sunday 18th June 2017

(if competition organisers require selected team prior to this date, further information will be announced on Scottish Archery website and social media)

Announcement of Team

Team will be announced on Scottish Archery website and by email to archers on Monday 19th June.

Additional Information

- Accommodation and transport to and from the venue is organised by the hosts
- Entry fees and accommodation are paid for in advance by Scottish Archery.
- Archers are responsible for arranging and financing travel to and from the venue.
- Mixed teams will be selected based on WA 50/70m qualification score with the highest scoring male and female archer in each division forming the team.

British Target Championships – Lilleshall 12th + 13th August 2017

Round: Saturday 12th August – WA 50m/70m and H2H
Sunday 13th August – WA 1440 (including Home Nations Match)

Team: 2 lady recurve, 2 gent recurve, 2 lady compound, 2 gent compound

Team Selection:

The team will be selected based on highest cumulative scores comprising 2 x WA 1440 rounds and 2 x WA 50m/70m rounds shot in open competition at Scottish, UK or World record status shoots during the selection period. [conversions from Imperial rounds are not eligible for selection]

Selection Period: 1st April 2017 to closing date of competition
(closing date likely to be 16th July 2017 but has not been confirmed by tournament organisers)

Announcement of Team

Team will be announced on Scottish Archery website and by email to archers.

Additional Information

All archers wishing to be considered for a team place **MUST** enter the competition before the closing date. Competition information will be available on Archery GB website.

Entries will be made through the Sport 80 website and archers are responsible for checking when entries open and registering with Sport 80.

Team members are expected to shoot both days of competition and are responsible for making their own travel arrangements to Lilleshall.

Team members will have their entry fee refunded.
