



## **Scottish Senior Team Manager**

Scottish Archery is looking to appoint a senior team manager for the Scottish senior team attending the Home Nations matches. These events take place 3 times per year and include:

- Senior Euronations (first weekend in July)
- British Outdoor Championships (second weekend of August)
- British Indoor Championships (first weekend of December)

The Senior Team Manager role would provide an excellent opportunity for anybody looking to get experience of team management at a Home Nations level with potential to progress on to international team management.

Team Manager role involves:

- Three weekends away per year with the Scottish Senior Team
- Close liaison with team members and tournament organisers prior to each event
- Attending Team Managers meetings at each event
- Supporting the Team throughout each event including awareness of travel plans and accommodation, shooting times and format, refreshments and any issues on the field
- Ensuring athletes adhere to Senior Team Code of Conduct
- Supplying a report to Performance and Communication Directors after each event
- Obtaining a Team photo at each event and photos of prizing giving involving any Team members

What you get:

- All expenses paid for attending team events
- Opportunity to gain team management experience and assist Scotland to Home Nations success
- Scottish Archery kit including shirt, trousers, jacket and hat to be worn when acting as team manager, but maybe worn at other times

- Flexible
- Good working knowledge of rules and regulations of relevant archery competitions
- Ability to deal with any conflict

The appointed Team Manager's first event will be the Senior Euronations in England, 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> July 2017.
