

International Representation Funding Criteria

Background

Scottish Archery may provide financial assistance to affiliated Scottish archers who are selected to represent GB at self-funded international competitions. Funding is available for both Junior and Senior archers*. To ensure justifiable expense and equity of access the following criteria are now in place for archers applying for funding.

Objectives of Funding International Representation

- Allow elite archers from Scotland the opportunity to represent Great Britain and gain experience and results that would allow them to access other funding streams in the future through world ranking position, AGB funded programmes and sponsorship.
- Ensure cost is not a barrier to high performance aspirations of Scottish archers

Awards of Funding are based on:

- The applicant being an affiliated Scottish Archery member and eligible to shoot for the GB archery team.
- The applicant demonstrating that they can be competitive at an international level. For seniors this is based on achieving the scores detailed below.
- The applicant not being in receipt of any AGB funding for the trip.
- Scottish Archery not exceeding the maximum amount allocated for international representation in a given year (currently the fund is £4000 per annum).

Application process:

- Applications for funding must be received within 1 week of the archer receiving notification from AGB that that have been selected for the team.
- Applications should be emailed to Scottish Archery administrator, Jacqui Dunlop with details of event, scores achieved during selection period and estimated cost of trip.
- Applications will be considered by a panel of 3 board members, including Director of Performance and outcome of application notified within 2 weeks of receipt.

Conditions:

- Retrospective applications will not be considered.
- Funding awards may be spent only on travel, accommodation and entry fees for GB representation at recognised international events in target and field archery.
- Archers must provide receipts when available to support their funding application
- Archers receiving money from Scottish archery are required to acknowledge financial support when announcing or highlighting their selection on social media
- Archers must provide a report for the website within two weeks of returning from a supported event

^{*} Para archers achieving international representation are already fully funded by AGB for international trips.



Funding Criteria

Juniors and Cadets

Juniors and Cadets who are selected to the GB team for non-funded trips (including indoor European and World events, Europa Cup, International Youth Team events and Field events) can apply for up to 50% of the cost of the trip to a maximum of £500.

Seniors

Available funding is up to 50% of the cost of the trip to a maximum of £500 per trip.

To be eligible for Scottish Archery funding senior archers must achieve the following scores at record status events during the designated AGB selection period. Scores are based on ensuring a funded archer is competitive at an international level (e.g. top 16 in a target ranking round, top 8 in field).
