

SAA Code of Conduct for Senior Teams and Squads

Archers selected to attend Scottish senior squad and/or to represent Scotland at any archery competition are expected to abide by the following code of conduct. All archers are assumed to have read and agree to the statements below when they accept their team/squad place.

- 1) To behave in a manner befitting a representative of your country when attending squad/team events. This includes arriving on time, in appropriate attire (as specified by team/squad management) and following instructions issued by team/squad management.

- 2) To treat team/squad members, management, officials and competitors with respect.

Any behaviour deemed not to be in accordance with this code of conduct should be reported to the SAA board via the team manager, high performance coach or director of performance. The subject of any such report will be notified and the matter investigated and dealt with in line with the SAA disciplinary policy.
