AAC Open Awards	Awards shall be given according to entries received subject to a minimum of: - 1-2 entries = Gold only, Trophies for main categories 3-5 = Gold & Silver, 6+ = Gold, Silver & Bronze. Recurve = Ladies, Gents, Juniors & Novices Compound = Ladies, Gents, Juniors & Novices Longbow and Barebow = Dependant on entries.
Thistle Awards	Shoot for badges.
Drug Testing	Archers may at any time are liable for drug testing and if competitors are approached to give samples they must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as appositive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent of guardian, giving consent for a drug test to be permitted if sought.
Photography	Provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, must register with the tournament Secretary on arrival.
Refreshments	A selection of hot food and drinks will be available on the day. Get your orders in early for the bacon rolls, and carrot cake.
Other Information Camping Bosses and Carbon arrows	Camping and shower facilities Available £7 per tent.£10 per campervan Danage and Foam and Straw bosses will be used,on "H" frames, all though backing material will be used, any archers worried about pass throughs should bring their own backing material. As the ground is a multi-purpose playing field all lost arrows cannot remain unaccounted for. It is a rule to shoot on this ground that all arrows are identifiable to the archer.
