Juniors who choose to shoot the senior round for senior prizes must pay Full adult fee. They will not be eligible for Junior Awards. CHEQUES made payable to Balbardie Archers. Closing Date	Saturday 1 st September or before if the shoot fills up.

World Archery Rounds	In addition to the 1440 rounds, Metrics 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 may be available subject to entries. Awards will be dependent on entries received. Availability of both long and short metric will be dependent on entries as those who have decided to shoot the full round will have priority. Saturday and Sunday will be run as two separate competitions.
Scoring	Double Scoring
Bosses	Balbardie uses straw bosses on H frames
Dress Regulations	Archery GB dress rules apply – refer to rules of shooting.
Practice Arrows	Three rounds of practice arrows at 9am
Start of Competition	Competition will start at conclusion of inspection/practice subject to judge's decision.
Registration	Registration will be open from 8am on both days. Archery GB cards will be inspected so please ensure you bring either your card or receipt to show you have paid your AGB membership.
Event Format	Rounds will be shot in order of 90/70, 70/60, 50 and 30 metres both days. (or equivalent distances for Metric Rounds) Both Days 6 arrow ends will be shot at 90/70 and 70/60 in 4 minutes. Both Days 3 arrow ends will be shot at 50/30 in 2 minutes. Shoot will be run as either single or double detail subject to entries.

If you have decided just to shoot a short metric then please aim to arrive at the ground by 12:00pm. Your practice ends will be shot at a time decided by the judges but you will be informed of when these will commence.</p>
