<b>Dates</b>	17 and 18 June 2017
<b>Entry Fee</b>	<p>Adult: Both days £26.00, single day £15.00, ½ day (Sunday only) £8.50.          Junior: Both days £16:00, Single day £10.00, ½ day (Sunday only) £5.00.          *Novice archers are those who are in their first year of shooting.</p> <p>Before the closing date refunds will be at the discretion of the tournament organiser. After closing date – no refunds          BACS Payments - See details shown on entry form. Cheques payable to Penicuik Archers:</p> <p>An acknowledgement of your entry will be issued by email therefore notification of your email address would be appreciated. If you do not provide a decipherable email address then confirmation of receipt of your entry will not be issued.</p> <p>For those archers who do not wish to shoot the round appropriate to their age and /or gender but wish to take part in the competition, the option to shoot alternative rounds is available on Sunday only. You can opt to shoot either the Ladies or Gents 1440 round, metric rounds (I-V) or if you want to shoot a ½ day round Long or Short metric rounds will also be available.</p> <p><b>Note: Records and claims are only available to those archers who shoot the round which is commensurate with their gender and age in accordance with Archery GB rules.</b></p>
<b>Special Note</b>	Please ensure the organiser is aware of any special requirements you may have prior to the attending to shoot, please do not assume that we already know about your needs.
<b>Closing Date</b>	3 June 2017 or when shoot full.
<b>Guest of Honour</b>	TBC
<b>Judges</b>	Liz Garrigan, Chairman of Judges: Bob Provan, Norrie McLean and Curtis Hirst.
<b>Registration</b>	Registration available from 08:00 on both days. All Membership cards must be shown during registration. Should you not be in possession of your 2016/17 Archery GB affiliation card please bring proof that your membership has been paid to your Club/SAA/Archery GB.
<b>Practice &amp; Event Timings</b>	Assembly at 8:45am on both days. There will be two rounds of practice which will commence following assembly and at the direction of the Chairman of Judges. The competition will start immediately after the practice session ends.
<b>Event Format:</b>	<p><b>Saturday 17 June 2017</b>          Following practice the WA 70/60/50Metre round will be shot in a single detail with 6 arrows shot in 4 minutes – the 50 Metre round will be shot using individual 80cm faces for each archer – score zone 5 – 10 only (no black or white scoring zones provided) .          On completion of the ranking rounds there will be a short break whilst archers are seeded for the H2H rounds. This will be the only planned break. Official practice for the afternoon session will take place during this time. All archers will go forward into the H2H - higher placed archers may receive a bye in the earliest round. Matches will be shot to current WA rules. Juniors are invited to shoot on equal footing with the Seniors. A 60M H2H will be shot if there are sufficient entries (minimum 3 archers) otherwise junior entries will be placed in the 70 metre round.</p>

	<p>Those archers who enter the 720 rounds and shoot longbow or barebow will be classified as Recurve archers for the H2H component.</p> <p><b>Sunday 18 June 2017</b></p> <p>Following practice the Ladies, Gents, and Metric rounds will be shot. Note: Junior Gents shooting the Metric 1 and Junior Ladies shooting the Metric 2 rounds are eligible for WA Silver (Cadet) Stars</p> <p>.</p> <p>The rounds may be shot with either as 4 archers per boss, double detail or alternatively a single wave, maximum 3 archers per boss.</p> <p>Following practice: Ladies / Gents 1440 FITA round (90m/70m and 70m/60m, 6 arrows in 4 minutes on 122cm face).</p> <p>Lunch</p> <p>50m and 30m – To be shot as 3 arrows in 2 minutes on a single 80 cm face (one face per boss).</p>
<b>Target Lists and Results</b>	Results and Target lists will be available from the Scottish Archery Website ( <a href="http://www.scottisharchery.org.uk/events">www.scottisharchery.org.uk/events</a> ). The results will be published as soon as practicable.
<b>Bosses</b>	Penicuik Archers will use straw bosses placed on H frame stands at this events.
<b>Prizes</b>	Prizes will be awarded on the results from the combined placing at the conclusion of the two day event and will be dependent on entries. Both days (3 rounds) must be shot to be eligible for prizes.
<b>Target Awards</b>	WA Target and WA Star Awards may be claimed by archers achieving the prerequisite scores on either day of the shoot. Thistle and Penny awards will be available to purchase for the 1440 Rounds.
<b>Drug Testing</b>	Archers competing at the tournament may be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to be tested will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries (under 18) must be acknowledged by a parent or guardian, giving consent for drug test to be conducted permitted, if approached.
<b>Smoking</b>	This is a non-smoking event. If you feel the need to smoke and/or vape Penicuik Archers ask that you retire well behind the tented area.
<b>Photography</b>	In view of the provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults policy, those who wish to take video or photographs at this event are asked to register their details with the Tournament Organiser at the registration desk before carrying out such activities. If parents/carers have any particular concerns about their child or a young person being photographed or filmed they should inform the tournament organiser.
<b>Lost arrows</b>	All lost arrows <b>must</b> be reported to a judge or a member of the field party. It is the responsibility of the archer to make ensure that all their arrows are accounted for – before leaving as this is a school playing field. If a lost arrow is found please remember to let someone in the field party or a judge know the arrow has been found.
<b>Car Parking</b>	Would all archers please park their car in the area zoned off for parking. Only certain categories of archers <b>may</b> be permitted to park behind the tent line and this will be at the shoot organisers' discretion. (It will also be dependent on the condition of the ground/field).
<b>Refreshments</b>	Penicuik Archers intend to sell food (bacon butties, burgers etc.) and hot and cold drinks throughout the weekend.
<b>Dress Rules</b>	<b>Archers must comply with Archery GB dress regulations</b>
