Entry Fee	<p>Adult: Both days £26.00: Single day £15.00; ½ day £8.50 Junior Both days £16:00: Single day £10.00; ½ day £6.50</p> <p>Before the closing date refunds will be at the discretion of the tournament organiser. After closing date – no refunds.</p> <p>Payment details on entry form, please note new name and account details.</p> <p>For those archers that don't want to shoot the round appropriate for their age and gender but wish to take part in the competition, the option to shoot an alternative round selected from Ladies and Gents 1440 and Metric I to V is available on Saturday only. For archers who would prefer not to shoot the full day the half day Long or Short Metric Round will be available on Saturday only.</p> <p>Note: only Ladies and Gents WA1440, Metric I to V and WA 720 rounds will be eligible for record claims/awards and only for those archers who shoot the round commensurate with their gender and age in line with Archery GB rules.</p>

Registration	Registration from 8:00am on both days. Membership cards will be required. Should you not be in possession of your 2016/17 affiliation card please bring proof that you have paid your membership to your Club/Archery GB.
Practice & Event Timings	Assembly at 8:45am on both days. There will be two rounds of practice which will commence following assembly and at the direction of the Chairman of Judges. The competition will start immediately after the practice session ends.
Event Format:	<p>WA 1440 will be shot in the order of 90/70, 70/60, 50 and 30 metres on both days (or equivalent Metric round distances)</p> <p>Both days will be shot as a single wave with a maximum of three archers per boss</p> <p>For Saturday: At the longest two distances: 6 arrow ends will be shot within 4 minutes. At the shorter two distances: 3 arrow ends will be shot in 2 minutes The longest two distances will be shot on 122 cm faces The shorter two distances will be shot on 80 cm faces (one face per boss)</p> <p>For Sunday (WA 1440) All distances: 6 arrow ends will be shot within 4 minutes The longest two distances will be shot on 122 cm faces The shorter two distances will be shot on 80 cm 6 zone faces (individual faces), if space/entries permit Longbow and Bare bow may share an 80cm 10 zone face</p> <p>For Sunday (WA 720) All distances: 6 arrow ends will be shot within 4 minutes The 70m and 60m rounds will be shot on 122 cm faces. The 50m rounds will be shot on 80 cm 6 zone faces (individual faces).</p> <p>For archers shooting a long metric this will be shot in the morning, for the short metric this will be in the afternoon. Archers shooting the short metric will be given two ends of practice. Archers shooting the Short Metric should be on the field for 12:00, practice will commence at the direction of the Chairman of Judges.</p>

Special Note	Please ensure the organiser is aware of any special requirements you may have, please do not assume that we already know.
Target Lists and Results	Results and Target lists will be published on the Scottish Archery Website (www.scottisharchery.org.uk/events)
Bosses	Penicuik Archers will use straw bosses placed on H frame stands.
Prizes	<p>Awards will be made according to the number of entries received, by the closing date, and based on the following minimum criteria of 1-2 Gold, 3-4 Gold and Silver, 5 + Gold, Silver and Bronze.</p> <p>Prizes will be awarded on the Sunday following the completion of all rounds. Prizes will be awarded for the double rounds, either 1440 or 720.</p> <p>Classification Awards: Awarded for the highest non placed archer in each classification, subject to number of entries.</p>
Target Awards	<p>WA Target Awards and WA Star Awards may be claimed by archers achieving the prerequisite scores for the appropriate rounds.</p> <p>Note: Junior Gents shooting the Metric I and Junior Ladies shooting the Metric II rounds are eligible for WA Silver (Cadet) Stars which are awarded based the score achieved (at least 1000 points required as a minimum).</p> <p>Penny Awards and Scottish Archery Thistle Awards will be available to purchase for archers achieving the prerequisite scores for the WA1440 Rounds.</p>
Drug Testing	Archers competing at the tournament may be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to be tested will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries (under 18) must be acknowledged by a parent or guardian, giving consent for drug test to be conducted, if approached.
Smoking	This is a non-smoking event. If you feel the need to partake Penicuik Archers ask that you retire well behind the tented area. This rule also applies to electronic cigarettes.
Photography	<p>In view of the provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults policy, those who wish to take video or photographs at this event are asked to register their details with the Tournament Organiser at the registration desk before carrying out such activities.</p> <p>If parents/carers have any particular concerns about their child or young person being photographed or filmed they should inform the tournament organiser.</p>
Lost arrows	All lost arrows must be reported to a judge or a member of the field party. As this is a school playing field it is the responsibility of the archer to make sure that all their arrows are accounted for – before leaving the field. If a lost arrow is found, please remember to let someone in the field party or a judge know.
Car Parking	Would all archers please park their car in the area zoned off for parking. Only certain categories of archers may be permitted to park behind the tent line and this will be at the shoot organisers' discretion. (It will also be dependent on the condition of the ground/field).
Refreshments	Penicuik Archers will be selling food (bacon butties, burgers etc.) and hot and cold drinks will be available throughout the weekend.
Dress Rules	Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations. Archers must comply with these Archery GB dress regulations
