



2017 Eastern Area Junior & Novice Showdown

For those less experienced archers who have not yet or only recently ventured into competitions there's now a competition just for you!

This competition is for Junior and Novice Archers who are members of a Scottish Archery affiliated club in the Eastern Area of Scotland.

The competition is non-record status, there is no dress code and it does not count as a ranking event. It's all about making some new friends, shooting some good arrows, and trying to win some prizes.

There will be awards for each individual competition as well as overall winners. Throw in a few spot prizes for best gold, worst white and highest scoring arrow on the wrong target and we should have something for everyone.

The downside, we can only accommodate 32 archers, so book early to avoid disappointment.

And now for the small print

Entries

All archers must be affiliated to Archery GB through clubs in the Eastern Area of Scotland.

A junior is someone who is under 18 years old at the start of the competition.

A novice is an archer who is completely new to the sport of archery and is within the first 12 months of participating in archery

All archers must be able to show their Archery GB membership card, or a club receipt as proof of affiliation.

All the normal bow classes (Recurve, Compound and Longbow) are permissible.

The total cost for the league is £10 per archer, that's all three competitions for a tenner!

Due to entry numbers being limited we ask that an entry form is completed and sent to the organiser with payment by 14th January 2017.

Competition

The competition will be a ½ Portsmouth. So, that's just 30 arrows, shot at a 60cm face, from 20 yards. We will shoot 3 arrow ends so it's not too much hard work for each end and that should allow us to complete the competition in under 2 hours.
