Whilst Juniors & Novice archers are welcome to attend they will be classified within the overall adult scores. There are no awards for novice category as the Scottish Novice Championship awards are presented at the SAA U21, Junior and Novice Championship (October 2016).

RECURVE LONGBOW BAREBOW	WA 18m (FITA) – 40cm single face Archers shooting these bow styles may elect to shoot a three spot vertical face – see entry form
COMPOUND	WA 18m (FITA) - 40cm triple vertical face
General Information	Double detail. 4 Archers per boss
FEES	£11.00 per person per session (£22.00 to shoot both sessions) – Refunds at organisers discretion and none given after closing date.

CLOSING DATE	Saturday 23 January 2016 Entries will not be processed until the entry form and fee are received either by BACS & electronic entry (email completed word file - or just send that appropriate details) or by the usual Postal / cheque etc.
PRIZES	Ladies and Gents – Recurve, Compound, Longbow, Barebow awards will be based on the following entry criteria (2-3 = Gold, 4-6 = Silver, 7+ = Bronze). For those archers who elect to shoot in both sessions only the first round shot will count for the Scottish Championship’s prizes. Classification prizes - 1 st place only Visitors awards according to entry (minimum of two entrants in class). Visitors are those archers who are not affiliated to Scottish Archery (directly or through SAA club) Team trophies - single club 1st Ladies Recurve Team (2 Ladies) 1st Gents Recurve Team (2 Gents) 1st Compound Team (3 archers - mixed gender) Improvement Prize (Open) – highest improvement score between 2nd x 30 arrows compared to score achieved in the 1st x 30 arrows. Presidents Prize (Open) – awarded to archer competing in the Scottish Indoor Championships (SIC) for the first time Chiltern Trophy – SAA Junior Member - highest score with a Recurve bow. Scott Mould Trophy – SAA Junior Member - highest score with a Compound Bow.

Archery GB membership cards /WA Membership cards will be inspected. Any archer unable to produce their card or a receipt for membership fee will not be permitted to shoot.

Archery GB dress regulations apply

Arrows will be shot at straw bosses on H frames.

Last year’s trophy winners are requested to bring the trophies (cleaned) with them on the day or please arrange for the trophy to be returned to the organiser prior to the shoot.
