Novice category

Senior novice awards are for archers 21 or over who joined Archery GB since 1st October 2016. Novices under 21 will shoot in the under 21 category. There are no novice awards for U21 or juniors.

Allocation of entry places

Senior archers not competing in the Novice category will be put on a list in order of receipt and allocated temporary places in the requested session. These places will be confirmed after the junior prior date.

Priority for archers competing for awards is for entry only **not** session. Once a session is full archers will be offered places in the other session.

If the shoot is "sold out" prior to the priority date archers not shooting for awards will be removed in reverse order of receipt and places filled with eligible archers.

Drug Testing	Archers at this tournament will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for a drug test to be permitted, if sought.
Photography	Publicity photography and personal photography by relatives may take place if approved by the organisers . Parents are requested to indicate their consent on the entry form.
Disclaimer	Links Archers uses straw bosses on A Frames and does not provide suitable backing. Any archers who believe that they may have a pass through issue should bring suitable backing to prevent this. All archers competing should note that the organiser can only be held responsible for damage to arrows caused by the failure of a boss/stand until the completion of the first end of sighters. The onus is therefore on the archers shooting on a boss to ensure that it is inspected for damage to prevent failure.
