Photography	In view of the provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy those who wish to take photographs at this event must register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival.
World Archery Rounds	Sat: WA1440 Sun: WA70/50 + H2H
Dress Regulations	Archers must comply with Archery GB dress regulations Rule 307.
1440 Practice Arrows	Two ends of practice to commence at 9:15am
Start of competition	Competition will start after the conclusion of practice and / or inspection – as per Judges discretion.
WA Shooting	There will be either four or three archers per boss, dependant on entries 90/70: 70/60: metres 6 arrow ends will be shot within 4 minutes. At 50/30 Compounds will be shot using individual 80 cm (6 rings) 10-5 target faces (four per Boss or 3 if single wave. Recurve single face either way 3 arrow ends will be shot within 2 minutes. WA70 single target, WA50 individual six zone 80cm faces
Bosses	Danage domino, and straw, all on H frames. There will be limited supplies of backing material if in doubt bring your own!!!
Awards List	Recurve & Compound: Ladies and Gents Trophy and medals as per entries. Barebow and Longbow: medals as per entries. Classification awards: WA1440 round only – medals- entry dependent. Recurve Team for Double Round – 3 archers form same club (Mixed gender) Compound Team for Double Round– 3 Archers from same club (Mixed gender) Senior awards please mark on entry if you are over 50 years old to qualify David Brown Memorial Sword : handicap shoot based on 4 best rounds shot in 2017 competitions. See separate entry form. Based on WA1440 only George Green memorial Trophy , for best Under 18 competing at this event. World Archery Star Target awards may be claimed by archers achieving prerequisite scores. Thistle awards can be claimed for 900 , upwards.(£2.50 fee)
Drug Testing	Archers at this tournament will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for a drug test to be permitted, if sought.
