<b>Venue</b>	King's Pavilion, University Road, Aberdeen, AB24 3FX. See below for parking.
<b>Rounds</b>	Saturday: WA 70m/50m ranking round followed by Head-to-Head Matchplay Sunday: WA 1440 Round and Metrics 1-5
<b>Faces and Distances</b>	Saturday: Recurve, Barebow and Longbow – 122cm face, Compound – 80cm 5-X 6-zone face. Longbow archers will compete in the Recurve category for H2Hs Sunday: Various face sizes and distances as standard for 1440 round categories. Archers of any ability are welcome to enter and to shoot any distance they feel comfortable with.
<b>Timings</b>	<u>Practice</u> : 2 ends will commence immediately after assembly on both days <u>Registration</u> : Registration will be open from 8am. <u>Assembly</u> : at 9:15am on both days
<b>Awards</b>	There will be separate awards for the Saturday and the Sunday. Medals will be awarded 1-3, Sunday Novice/Junior/Master categories included. Please select the appropriate class in the form.

<b>Rules</b>	World Archery rules will apply to this event.
<b>Bosses</b>	Layered Foam bosses will be used on H frame stands
<b>Facilities</b>	Toilets on site in King's Pavilion including disabled toilets, first aid kit available and drinking water in staff room in the pavilion. Catering TBC
<b>Scoring</b>	IANSEO scoring system will be used. Double scoring will be used. We will be using electronic scoring system via participants phones. Details of how to download the Scorekeeper app are available on the entry form on Google Docs.
<b>Parking</b>	Parking is available onsite in the University Car Parks and on University Road, the parking inside the field gate is reserved for disabled participants and volunteers and can be accessed from Regent Walk.
<b>Lord/Lady Paramount</b>	TBC
<b>Drugs etc...</b>	No smoking/vaping is permitted in front of the tent line and preferably not on the sports field at all. This event is liable for drug testing. Please bear this in mind.
