## **Purpose**

The purpose of the Records subgroup it to:

- oversee Scottish Archery record claims.
- administer record claims and update records.
- review the process for applying for a record claim, and for updating live forms.

### **Main Duties:**

- Attend and contribute to subgroup meetings
- Contribute to the development of the subgroup action plan
- Complete any assigned actions decided at subgroup meetings in the timeframe required within the action plan

### Time commitment
