<b>Rounds:</b>	WA 18m. 60 arrows shot as two 30 arrow parts. This is to allow for scoring to take place. And results to be updated after 30 arrows.
<b>Faces and Distances</b>	WA 40cm face will be used. Single sports for Recurve, Longbow and Barebow. All compounds will shoot a 3-spot. Recurve, Longbow and Barebow archers may request a 3-spot when entering.
<b>Timings</b>	<i>Sighters:</i> 13:30am, 2 ends of practice will be given  <i>Registration:</i> Open from 12:30am  <i>Assembly:</i> 13:15pm

<b>Awards</b>	All who place in 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> will receive medals, irrespective of how many are in a category.
