

Scottish Archery Ranking Criteria

Target Indoor Senior and Junior



The Indoor rankings are compiled as an average of an archers top three **five** dozen round scores shot in an open competition of Scottish record status or higher. All scores will be converted to an WA18m for ranking purposes.

Indoor rankings will run on a twelve-month rolling basis and a season ending ranking will be published in April.

There will be junior rankings, but all juniors will be included in the general rankings also as there are no differences between the rounds shot.

The responsibility lies with the archer to provide substantiation for claimed scores by identifying a web link or other form of independent verification. (Paper copies of results are not acceptable). Scores shot outside of Scotland should be submitted no later than seven days following the shoot. The following information should be supplied:

- Name of archer
- Discipline
- Type of round shot
- Score for that round
- Name and date of tournament
- Results sheet

Please note archers will be ranked under the club through which they pay their affiliation fees. Direct members of Scottish Archery will be listed as Scottish Archery.
