ASSEMBLY

AM: 9.30am **PM:** Afternoon session will commence at 1.00pm or 45 minutes after morning session ends, whichever is later (Please be on site by 12.00pm)

PRACTICE: Practice will follow assembly

JUDGES: TBC

DRESS CODE: AGB Rules of Shooting 307 applies

DRUG TESTING: Archers are liable for drug testing and must comply if approached to give a sample. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. By signing the entry form, parents are consenting to their child being tested if approached

ROUNDS AVAILABLE: All rounds are open to all archers and not limited based on age/gender

Full day: Gents WA 1440, Ladies WA 1440/Metric 1, Metric 2 - Metric 5

Half Day: Long Metrics (Morning only)
Short Metrics (Afternoon only)

MEDALS:

Open competition – Medals will be presented for WA1440 and Metrics rounds. Long/Short metrics will also be recognised.

Handicap competition – Dependent on entry, up to 3 medals for best handicap adjusted scores achieved in the session across the board

VENUE: Strathallan Games Park, Pullar Avenue Bridge of Allan, FK9 4SR. **NB** The park does not have a postcode – this postcode is for the access road

FACILITIES: There are no disabled toilet facilities at this venue. Access to the toilets is via 2 or 3 steps. There will be a tea tent selling bacon rolls and home baking. A raffle will be held

PASS THROUGH: We use straw bosses. Any archers concerned about pass-through must bring their own backing material

LOST ARROWS: The venue is a sports field and all lost arrows **MUST** be found before competitors leave the field at the end of the day

SPIDER BADGES: These can be claimed by archers attending this competition and must be claimed on the day. Cost £2 each

PHOTOGRAPHY: This is a public area and we have no control over photography in the area. However, in line with AGB PCVAP policy, anyone wishing to take photos at the event must sign up with the Registrar

JUNIORS: must be accompanied by a parent or guardian throughout the event

ENTRY FEES: **Full day** - Seniors £12.00, Juniors £9.00. **Half day** – Seniors £8.00, Juniors £6.00

Valid AGB cards or receipts must be shown to the Registrar prior to the competition otherwise you will not be allowed to compete
