Photography	Bathgate Sports Centre is a public park and we cannot be held responsible for photography. In view of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, archers and their families wishing to take photos should register with the organisers.
World Archery Rounds	In addition to the 1440 rounds, Metrics 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 may be available subject to entries. Awards will be dependent on entries received.
Scoring	Double scoring
Bosses	Balbardie uses straw bosses on H frames
Dress Regulations	Archery GB dress rules apply – refer to rules of shooting.
Practice Arrows	Two rounds of practice arrows at 9am
Start of competition	Competition will start at conclusion of inspection/practice subject to judge's decision.
World Archery Shooting	Rounds will be shot in order of 90/70, 70/60, 50 and 30 metres both days. (or equivalent distances for Metric Rounds) There will be a maximum of four archers per boss. At 90/70: 70/60: metres 6 arrow ends will be shot within 4 minutes and at 50 and 30 metres 3 arrows in 2 minutes. Faces used will be in accordance with WA Rules. Compound archers may be given 6-zone scoring faces at the two shorter distances subject to entries.
Medals	Medals will be awarded subject to the minimum entry of: 1-2 Gold, 3 Gold and Silver, 4 + Gold, Silver and Bronze EASTERN AREA: Saturday only Recurve: Lady and Gent trophy Compound: Lady and Gent trophy Novice: Lady and Gent Novice trophy Juniors: Junior Gent or Lady trophies for their appropriate Metric rounds Team: Recurve – EA Gonfalon – Four members of Eastern Area Club Compound: Two archers from an Eastern Area Club Classification medals subject to entries. DOUBLE 1440 Round Recurve: Ladies and Gents Compound: Ladies and Gents Juniors shooting Metric Rounds (Juniors may shoot senior rounds for senior prizes – adult fee payable) Other prizes may be awarded but this will be at the organiser's discretion and determined by the number of entries. Distance awards/classification awards will be awarded subject to entries.
Drug Testing	Archers at this tournament will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for a drug tested to be permitted, if sought.
