Sunday – 2 x single WA70m, 60m and 50m.

**Faces and Distances**  
Recurve (Adult, Junior) – 70m at 122cm face.  
Recurve (Cadet, Masters) – 60m at 122cm face.  
Barebow (All age groups) – 50m at 122cm face.  
Longbow (All age groups) – 70m at 122cm face.  
Compound (All age groups) – 50m at 80cm 5-X ring face.

**Timings** *Practice:* A maximum of 45 minutes will be given for practice before the start of each round.

*Competition days:* Registration will be open from 8:00am

*Assembly:* at 8:45 am.

**Camping** Unfortunately, there will be no camping available at this event.

**Places to Stay** There are places to stay locally depending on COVID restrictions at the time.

**Dogs** Dogs are permitted on the field, not forward of the tent line. They must be on a lead at all times.

**Drugs etc** No smoking/vaping or alcohol is allowed on the field of play or in the tent area.

## **Coronavirus Information**

Before you attend the shoot, it is important that you have read and understand the following information. By entering this competition, you are agreeing that you will follow the guidance layed out below.

If you refuse to follow the guidance, then you may be asked to leave the Field of Play for the rest of the shoot. This decision will be taken by the Event Staff and Chair of Judges.

Each person on the field will be asked to fill in and sign a COVID disclaimer. Your temperature will be taken before you register and must be below 38 degrees.

**Please do not attend the competition if you present with any of the following symptoms or conditions:**

- High temperature,
- New, continuous cough,
- Loss of, or change in sense of taste or smell.
- You, or someone with who you have been in close proximity to has tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 14 days.

If you enter the competition and then proceed to test positive, please email the Tournament Organisers. We will give you a full refund.

### **On the day:**

- Only event staff, judges and comeptitors will be permitted on the field of play (max. 30)
- Athletes will not be allowed to have anyone with them when the competition is taking place.

- If you require assistance on the day (for example if you need an agent), please inform the TO when entering and tell us if this is the case.

## **Tents**

- One tent will be allowed per archer on the Field of Play.
- There will be areas marked A and B, please put your tents in the appropriate area, which corresponds to your shooting position. Please see attached Field of Play diagram.

## **Equipment Inspection**

- Equipment inspection will still take place, however the judges will not be permitted to touch any of your equipment.
- All the normal equipment rules according to WA will apply.
- When queuing to get your equipment checked, please remember to maintain 2m social distancing.
- Compound archers bows will not be weighed. Should the judges require your bow to be weighed during the shoot, the scales will be sanitised before and after their use.

## **Toilets**

- There will only be one person permitted in the toilets at any one time.

## **Scoring**

- Please maintain social distancing when at the targets.
- When it comes to handing scoresheets in, please place them on the waiting line once finished with all boxes filled and signed.
- Please mark and pull **ONLY YOUR** arrows.

## **PPE**

- When you are not shooting, you must wear a mask **AT ALL TIMES** unless you are exempt. Proof of exemption must be shown.
- Hand sanitiser will be provided at high touch areas such as the container, toilets and Judges tent. However, please bring your own as we have a limited supply.
