**DRESS CODE:** AGB Rules of Shooting 307 applies

**DRUG TESTING:** Archers are liable for drug testing and must comply if approached to give a sample. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. By signing the entry form, parents are consenting to their child being tested if approached

**ROUNDS AVAILABLE:** (9 dozen split into 3 dozen at each of 3 distances on 122cm face, 5 zone scoring)

**St George** (100/80/60 yd)

**Short Windsor** (50/40/30 yd)

**Albion** (80/60/50 yd)

**Junior Windsor** (40/30/20 yd)

**Windsor** (60/50/40 yd)

**Short Junior Windsor** (30/20/10 yd)

All rounds are open to all archers and not limited based on age/gender. All bowstyles welcome

**MEDALS:**

**Open competition** - Dependent on entry; all bowstyles will be recognised

**Handicap competition** – Dependent on entry, up to 3 medals for best handicap adjusted scores achieved in the session across the board

**VENUE:** Strathallan Games Park, Pullar Avenue Bridge of Allan, FK9 4SR. **NB:** The park does not have a postcode – this postcode is for the access road

**FACILITIES:** There are no disabled toilet facilities at this venue. Access to the toilets is via 2 or 3 steps. There will be a tea tent with bacon rolls and home baking. A raffle will be held on the day

**PASS THROUGHs:** We use straw bosses. Any archers concerned about pass-through must bring their own backing material

**LOST ARROWS:** The venue is a sports field and all lost arrows **MUST** be found before competitors leave the field at the end of the day

**SPIDER BADGES:** These can be claimed by archers attending this competition and must be claimed on the day. Cost £2 each

**PHOTOGRAPHY:** This is a public area and we have no control over photography in the area. However in line with AGB PCVAP policy, anyone wishing to take photos at the event must sign up with the Registrar

**JUNIORS:** must be accompanied by a parent or guardian throughout the event

**ENTRY FEES:** Seniors £12.00. Juniors £9.00

**Valid AGB cards or receipts must be shown to the Registrar prior to the competition otherwise you will not be allowed to compete**
