To the toxophilite paramount -

'The Frost-Bite Quaich'

An informal shoot; focus is on bettering the elements, rather than fellow archers.

1100 hrs – 1130 hrs - Registration

1130 hrs – Assembly & Inspection - followed by sighters (six arrows)

1200 hrs - Frost-Bite Shoot.

- Bow Styles – LongBow (RoS 206) / Recurve BareBow (RoS 204).
- Arrows – wooden or aluminium steles only please.
- Seniors & U18's:
Four dozen arrows at forty yards (80cm target face) 5 zone scoring.
- Juniors U14's:
Four dozen arrows at twenty yards (80cm target face) 5 zone scoring.
- Each detail to shoot six arrows per end – in groups of three.
- There will be no detail rotation - order of shooting will remain the same for each end.
- Extra arrows due to 'bouncers' are not allowed.
- Best Gold End – to be announced at random.
- Worst White End – to be announced at random.
- Most petticoats – please mark as 'P' on score sheet – show total for round - i.e. '4P'

Target Captains – Jnr Targets: TBC

When round has finished -
Please hand all signed & completed score sheets to Field Captain.

A fifteen minute comfort break will be followed by:
'The Whisky Trail Knockout'
Read on...

1430 hrs – The Whisky Trail Knockout

Each archer to shoot one arrow per end. (10 zone scoring)

Seniors – 40 yds – 80 cm target face.

U18's – 40 yds – 80 cm target face.

Juniors U14's – 20 yds – 80 cm target face.

Elimination:

- i. If an archer misses the target face (fails to score) he/she is out.
- ii. If all arrows are scoring – the lowest scoring archer(s) are out.
- iii. All remaining archers to keep shooting as above until only one archer remains.
- iv. If the final remaining archers draw – they must shoot again, until there is a winner.

Target #1 – Senior Prize – Bottle of Whisky

Target #2 – Junior U18's – Chocolate

Target #3 – Junior U14's – Chocolate

1500 hrs - All archers retire to the hall for **results & presentations.**

- Youngest competitor
- All archers still standing will receive a commemorative *'I SURVIVED'* badge.
