AM Session: Doors open 9.00am

PM Session: Doors open 12.30pm

SIGHTERS: Sighters will commence at 9.30am and 1.00pm. Max 4 archers per boss. Compounds will shoot on a vertical 3 spot face. Other bowstyles may request a 3 spot face but are not guaranteed one

JUDGES: TBC

DRESS CODE: AGB Rules of Shooting 307 applies

DRUG TESTING: Archers are liable for drug testing and must comply if approached to give a sample. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. By signing the entry form, parents are consenting to their child being tested if approached

BOWSTYLES: All bowstyles are welcome. Archers who wish to shoot a different bowstyle in the second session are free to do so and should complete two entry forms.

Compound archers should be aware that we have a limited supply of H-frames that will be used with straw bosses. Allocation to these targets will be on a first come, first served basis. Archers concerned about pass-through must bring their own backing material

MEDALS:

Open competition - Dependent on entry; all bowstyles will be recognised. Medals for single and double rounds

Handicap competition – All archers who declare their indoor handicap on the entry form will be entered into this competition. Up to 3 medals for best handicap adjusted scores achieved for both the single and double Portsmouth across the board

SPIDER BADGES: These can be claimed by archers attending this competition and must be claimed on the day. Cost: £2 each

PHOTOGRAPHY: This is a public building with a viewing area. Bannockburn Bowmen have no control over photography in the building or surrounding area. However in line with AGB PCVAP policy, anyone wishing to take photos at the event must sign up with the Registrar

JUNIORS: Must be accompanied by a parent or guardian throughout the event

ENTRY FEES: Single: £9 per entrant; **Double:** £16 per entrant. Juniors will be eligible for senior prizes.

Valid AGB cards or receipts must be shown to the Registrar prior to the competition otherwise you will not be allowed to compete

CLOSING DATE: Entry form and fees must be received by **Saturday 4th January 2020**
