If entries and space permit archers will all shoot in one wave. If this is the case, a maximum of three archers will be allocated to each boss. We will, however, ensure that there are enough breaks throughout the day to allow all competitors sufficient rest time.

NOTE: 50 & 30 metres distances for Compound competitors will be shot using individual 80 cm (6 rings) 10-5 zones target faces. (three/four faces per boss) as appropriate.
