Format	20yd on 60cm face. 2 ends of practice followed by round robin head to head. Max 10 divisions of 6 archers each. Full rules attached

Dress code	No cammo or denims. Club shirts or archery related tops preferred

Entries	As per attached form. All entries require best 2 scores from Portsmouth, WA18 or minimum 30 arrows shot at a club and witnessed by a club official
Closing Date	Friday 21 <sup>st</sup> February 2019
Photography	Publicity photography and personal photography by relatives may take place <b>if approved by the organisers</b> . Parents are requested to indicate their consent on the entry form.
Disclaimer	Mearns Archers use straw bosses on square frames and does not provide suitable backing. Any archers who believe that they may have a pass through issue should bring suitable backing to prevent this. All archers competing should note that the organiser can only be held responsible for damage to arrows caused by the failure of a boss/stand until the completion of the first end of practice. The onus is therefore on the archers shooting on a boss to ensure that it is inspected for damage to prevent failure.
Raffle	A raffle will be held before the awards.
Refreshments	There are no catering facilities at the Academy, just limited vending machines. There is a co-op supermarket close by. <b>There will be no formal lunch break</b> as archers will have natural breaks during the day

## SCOTTISH ARCHERY FACE TO FACE TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Tournament will be shot on a 60cm FITA face at 20yd. Higher divisions ( typically those shooting greater than 540 Portsmouth score) will shoot at a 3 spot face.
2. There will be a maximum of 10 divisions of 6 archers per division.
3. Archers will be grouped by ability so will be required to supply 2 scores as part of the entry procedure. The scores can be Portsmouth, WA 18 or a minimum 30 arrows on a 60cm face at 20yd shot in a club shooting day and witnessed by a club official. Compound scores using the compound 10 ring.
4. Archers are grouped by ability so there will be no separation of bow categories age or sex except possibly in the top divisions.
5. In each division the 6 archers will shoot against each other in a round robin match sequence as per the chart below. There will be 2 matches simultaneously on each boss. Archers competing against each other will shoot at the same time, one on the left target and one on the right. Shooting will follow the normal AB-CD alternating sequence. Standard FITA timing of 2 min for 3 arrows will be used
6. Matches will consist of 3 sets (ends) of 3 arrows. Scoring for each set will be - win 2 points, draw 1 point, loss 0 points. Highest point score after 3 sets is the winner. Match points will similarly be win 2 points, draw 1 point, loss 0 points.
7. If there are less than 6 archers in a division, bye matches will still be shot and scored.
8. At the end of shooting all matches, archers in each division will be ranked by match points gained with the top 3 gaining awards.
9. Tie breaks - archers with equal match points will take part in a one end shoot off followed, if required, by a one arrow, closest to centre, shoot off
10. Practice - All archers will have 2 ends of practice. Archers 1,2,3&4 prior to round 1 match, archers 5&6 prior to round 2 match. (practice is unlimited arrows in the 2 minute time period)
