Closing Date	Friday 27th July 2018
Start of Competition	Equipment inspection will commence at 9.15am followed by two ends of practise. Competition will start after practise.
WA Shooting	There will be a maximum of 3 archers per boss for single wave shooting, and 4 for double wave. The number of entrants will determine whether there is to be single or double wave shooting. 90/70m , 70/60m will shoot 6 arrow ends within 4 minutes. 50/30m will shoot 3 arrow ends shot within 2 minutes. 90/70/60m will shoot 122cm target face. 50/30m will shoot 80cm target face. Compounds will shoot 6 ring, 80cm face.
Bosses	Mainly layered foam with some Danage Domino, all on H frames. Archers requiring backing material are requested to bring their own as the few the club has may not meet your requirements.

Awards	Recurve and Compound : Ladies and Gents Trophy and medals as per entries. Barebow and Longbow : medals as per entries. Senior Awards : Please mark on entry form if you are 50yrs plus to qualify. World Archery Star Target Awards may be claimed by archers achieving the necessary scores. Thistle Awards can be claimed for 900 upwards, with an associated fee of £2.50.
Dress Code	All archers must comply with Archery GB dress regulations Rule 307.
Drug Testing	Any archer attending will be liable for drugs testing and may be asked to give a sample, for which non compliance will be treated as a positive result. Junior entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian giving consent for drug testing if requested.
Judges	TBC
Archery GB and World Archery Cards	All competitors must have cards available for inspection upon request.
Additional Information	All competitors arrows must be identifiable to the archer. All lost arrows must be recovered before departing the field. Glasgow Archers and Craigholme School will not be responsible for any loss or damage. Craigholme Sports Facility is open to the public and therefore no restrictions can be made regarding photography at the venue.
