Report of Open Day and Papingo held on 11-Aug-2019

Kilwinning Round:

The weather was very wet but winds were light.

After 3 dozen arrows, and continuous rain, the competitors voted, unanimously, to shoot the rest of the competition without taking a break. As a result, the competition finished at 13:30hrs, giving plenty of time for everybody to 'get a bite' then and dry off, a bit, before the Papingo shoot at the Abbey Tower.

The full results, and awards, for the Kilwinning Round are listed below.

Papingo:

The Papingo started at 14:58. The weather quickly worsened and it got very, very, wet. The wind also got stronger, but it was in a direction that allowed shooting to continue.

Bob Inglis struck the bird with the 12th arrow, of the competition, to win the Rose Bowl and Gold/Green rosette. Shooting continued until 17:06 with no further hits although the Doo had a few narrow misses. This included one pole strike and an arrow (shot by John McKellar) that caught the pole just behind the Doo and executed a full 360 degree pirouette around the pole before heading back down. The doo did not flinch at this near miss!

The Award Ceremony was held in the Kilwinning Abbey Tower at 16:30, to allow the Irish contingent to get away and catch their boat back over to Belfast.
